

Champaign-Urbana Weather Highlights – March 2006

Temperature – ranged from 75°F on March 31 to 19°F on March 22. While the monthly average high temperature and the monthly average mean temperature were above normal, they were not of noteworthy rank.

Precipitation – no daily records were set this month. Precipitation was slightly above-normal, 3.46" (0.25" above normal). It is probably safe to say that the 2005-06 snowfall season is over. We measured a total of 14.0 inches of snow, 12.2 inches below the normal of 26.2 inches. This is the third year in a row with below-normal snowfall. We measured 16.2 inches in the 2003-04 season and 13.4 inches in the 2004-05 season. Even with the meager 14.0 inches, it was only the 21st lowest winter snowfall total in Champaign-Urbana history. The winter of 1953-54 was the lowest with 6.7 inches. Snowfall records for Champaign-Urbana go back to 1903.

Observer's Note – the wind statistics reported here and on the voicemail recording are not part of the climatic archive maintained by this office. They are from another Water Survey network co-located with our site (see below).
